6. The third man started his prayer by praising God. David does this in the Psalms. Read Psalm 8:1. Why do you think beginning a prayer with God's praise is important?

7. God reminded the third man the importance of trusting Him in all things. Read Psalm 9:10. According to this verse, how can we know we can trust God in all things?

8. The third man then asked God to meet his needs. Read Philippians 4:19. In the video, God said His people often get mixed up with the difference between their wants and needs. In this verse, God promises to supply all our needs. Have you found yourself praying for wants that you thought were needs? Explain.

9. The third man asked God for forgiveness. God responded by saying he was forgiven and the sins were forgotten. Read Hebrews 8:12.

A) What does this verse say about God's memory of our sins?

B) What result do you get your life when bring to remembrance old sins that you've committed.

C) Read Romans 8:1. If God feels this way about you, what right do you have to feel another way?

D) How, when you don't look at your sins the way God looks at them, does it affect your walk with Him?

10. The third man said that he had let God down so many times. God said you didn't let me down, I was always holding you up.

A) Read Isaiah 41:9b-10. What did God ask us to do in these verses?

B) What did God promise He would do for us in these verses?

11. God told the third man, "you talk way too much."

A) How can talking too much to God interfere with our prayer life?

B) Read Psalm 46:10. What does sitting still and listening to God allow us to do?

12. God reminded the third man, "if you will do the possible, I will do the impossible in your life."

A) Read James 1:22. What are "possible" things that we know from God's Word that we already know we're supposed to be doing?

B) Read Ephesians 3:20. Can you think of some things in your life that you limit God's power in your life?

C) At the end of the prayer, the third man spends time personally worshipping God. Take some time right now to bring your worship to God.
