GETTING TO KNOW YOU

1. When people come to you for help, what do they usually want help with?

2. What is something you think everyone should do at least once in their lives?

3. Looking back over last weekend's message, what was your biggest take away?

INTO THE BIBLE

Pastor Jim's message this week was on the phrase, "Follow Me." We are called Christians (literally "little Christs"). As we imitate Christ, we are called to impact others for Him. In this lesson, we'll look at another phrase Jesus used in the New Testament, "Come and see..."

1. Read John 1:35-41.

A) What do you think the two disciples thought when they heard John say, "Behold, the Lamb of God" (verses 35-36)?

B) In curiosity, the two disciples followed Jesus (verses 37-38). What question did Jesus ask them?

C) What was their answer to Jesus' question?

D) In verse 39, Jesus says, "Come, and you will see." Jesus offered an opportunity to come and spend time with Him. What was the disciples choice?

E) In verse 41, how did spending a day with Jesus impact Andrew?

2. Read John 1:43-49. Jesus intentionally went to Galilee and found Phillip. He invited Phillip to "Follow Me."

A) After spending time with Jesus, who did Phillip reach out to?

B) Phillip tells Nathanael that he has found the Messiah, Jesus of Nazareth. What was Nathanael's response?

C) Phillip didn't choose to argue with Nathanael at this point. Instead, what did he ask Nathanael to do?

D) What are the two things Jesus told Nathanael (verses 47-48)?

E) Because of Phillip's willingness to bring his friend to Jesus, what do we see happen in verse 49?

3. In John 4:1-26, Jesus came to Samaria and began talking to a Samaritan woman. She came to draw water from the well and He offered her living water. He confronted her with the sin in her life and He also told her that He was the Messiah. Read John 4:28-30.

A) Jesus had made a huge impression on the woman at the well. As she was leaving the well and went into town, what did she invite the people to do?

B) Read John 4:39-42. What happened because of this woman's testimony?

Jesus invited the two disciples to come and see and they believed. Phillip invited Nathanael to come and see and he believed. The woman at the well invited many people to come and see and many believed. In today's world, we can't physically bring people to Jesus. Pastor Jim in his message said, "We should be able to use our lives as an example to follow."

DIGGING DEEPER

Read 1 Corinthians 11:1, 1 Corinthians 4:16-17, Philippians 3:17, Philippians 4:9, and 2 Timothy 3:10-11.

1. Thinking on these Scriptures, who is called to be the physical representation of Jesus here on earth today?
